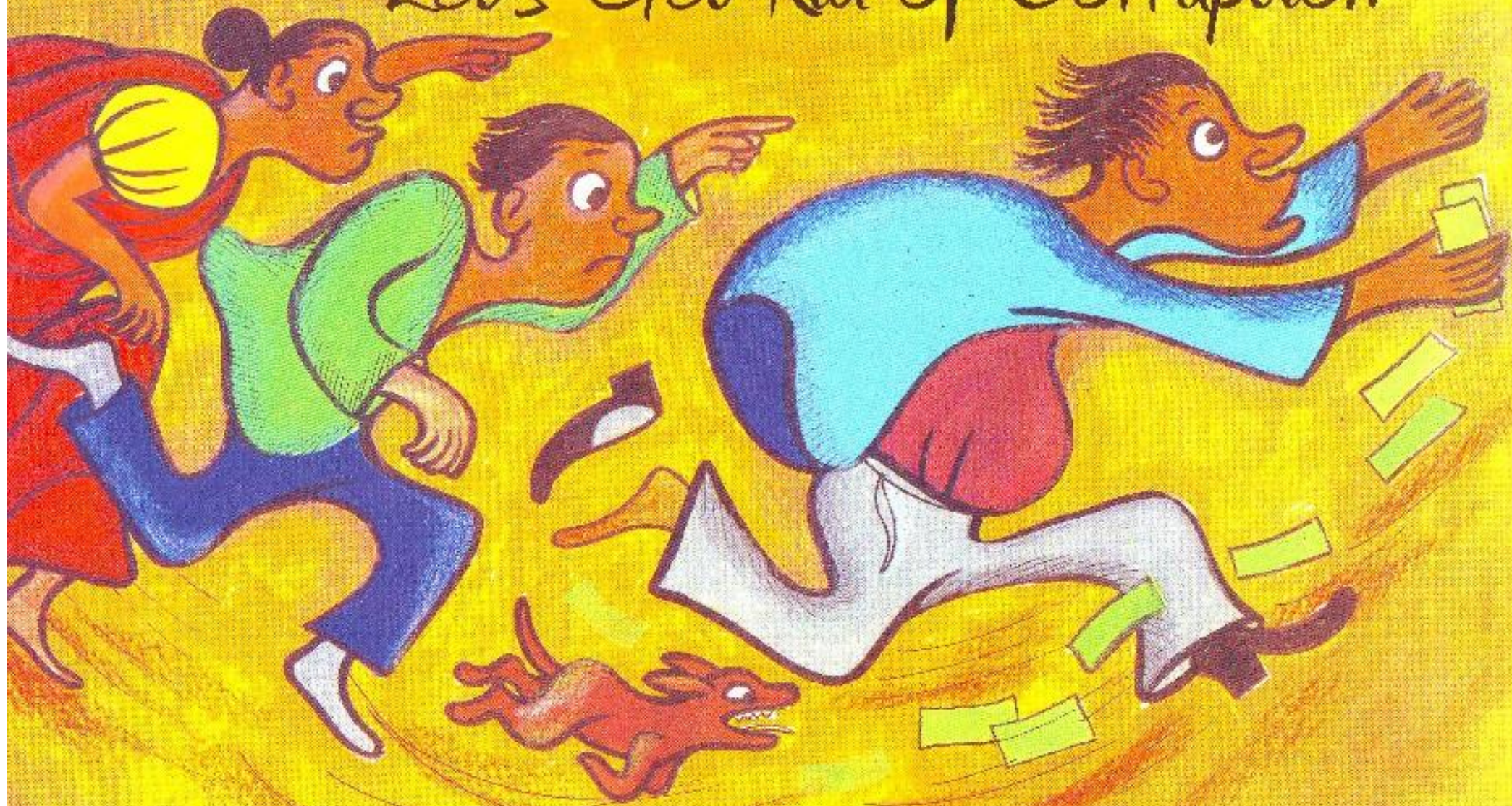


Let's Get Rid of Corruption

Cheat !


What is your name son ?

Mr. Boteju please consider my case favourably...


Consider you have won. Mrs. Beta

trouble.....

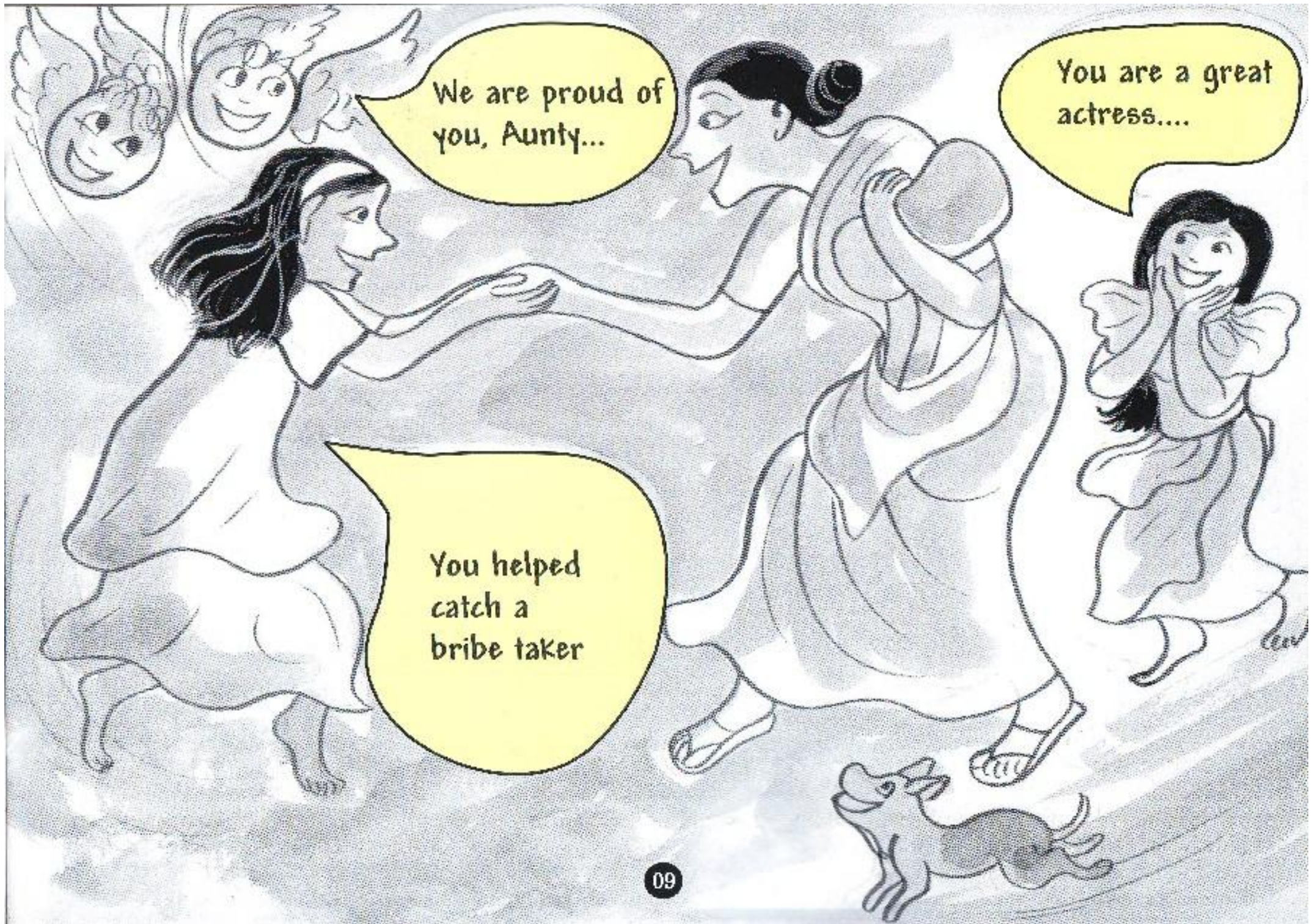
No sir, I know

this office sir...


Cowards

That's very true....

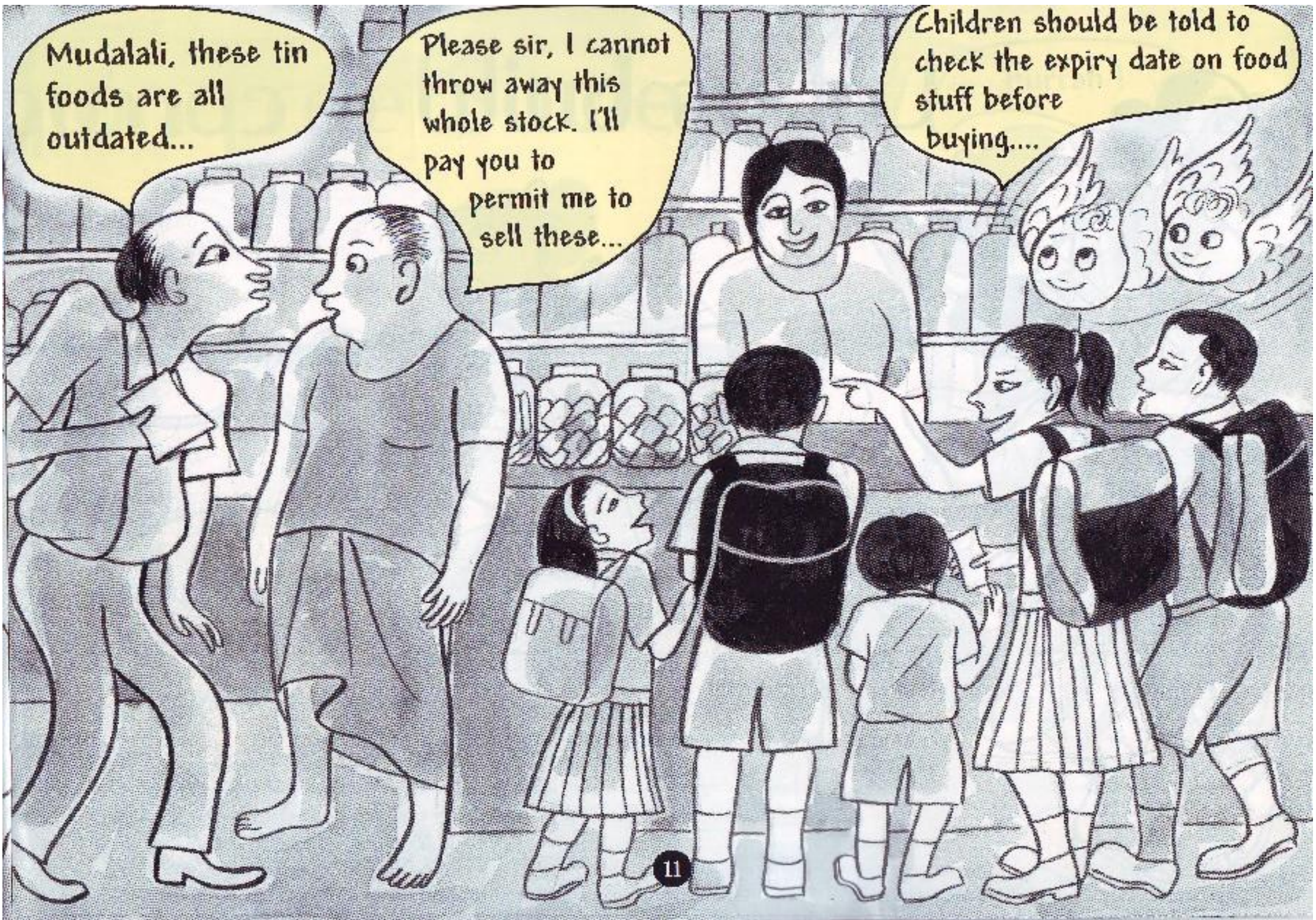
If we all join hands to get rid of corruption, I am sure we will succeed.

Good luck to the girls...




Into the Jeep, all

brewing goes on.




Madam, we are the owners of Linton Motor Company. We can help you in any way. Could you appoint my daughter as head girl of the school?

And not because she is a wealthy one...




What does giving a bribe mean, Thatha?

Stick to it...

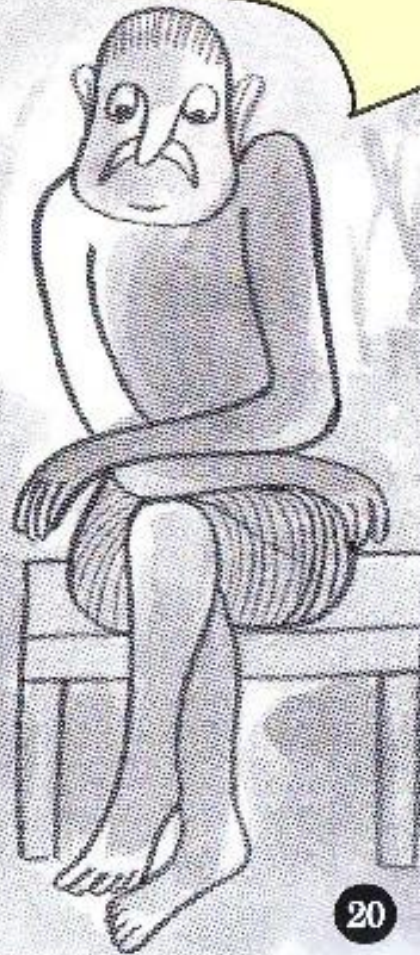
Awful times ! We can't get the simplest job done without paying money on the sly.


Who has so much money ?

The officials concerned too want an end to this menace


It is a blessing if everyone agrees to do so...

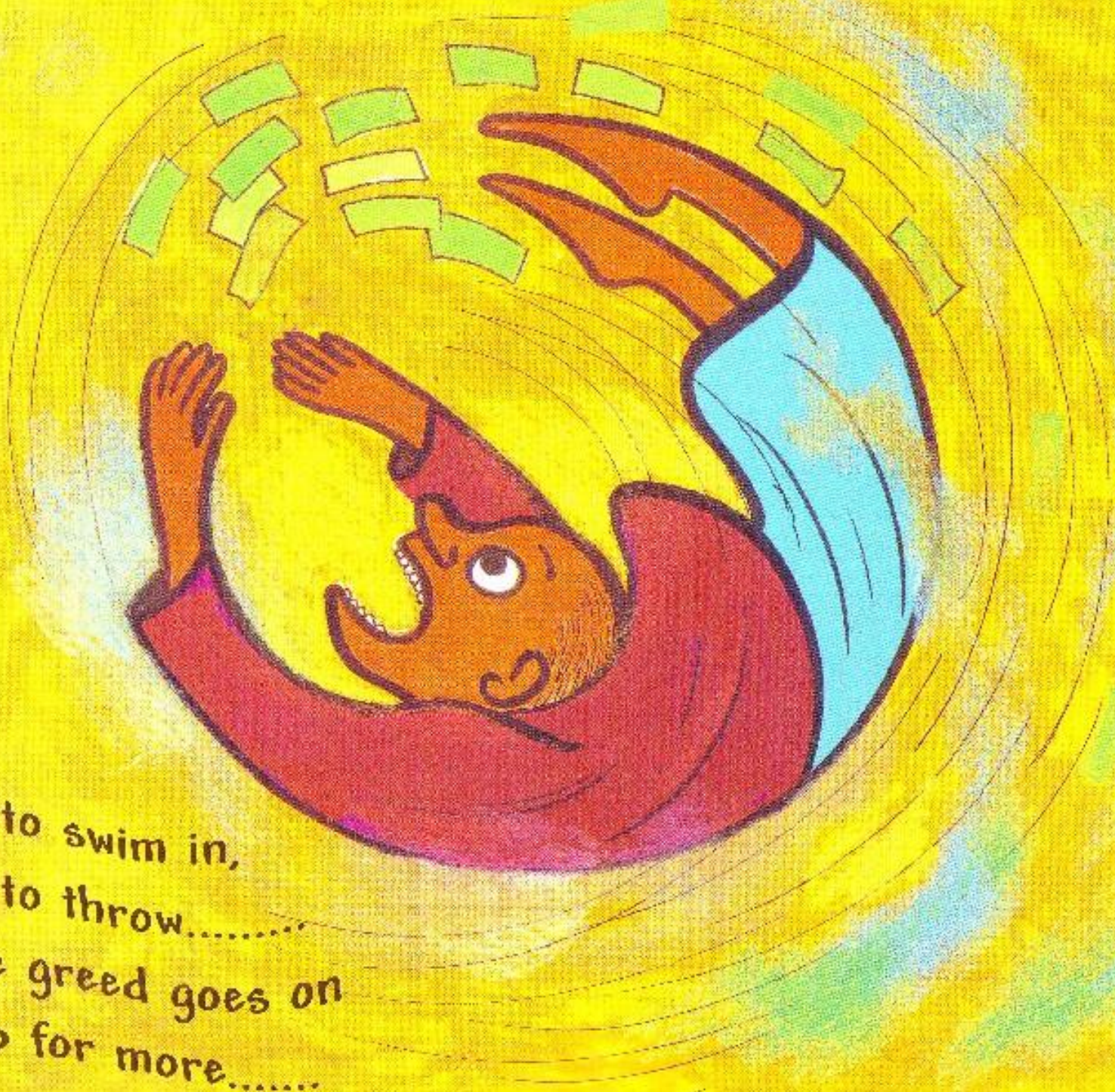
